The Chair of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1970 (2011) concerning Libya presents his compliments to the Permanent Representatives of Member States and to the Permanent Observers of Non-Member States to the United Nations and wishes to convey the following:

On **27 April 2016**, the Committee approved the **addition of the entry** specified below to its List of individuals and entities subject to the assets freeze, travel ban and other measures relating to attempts to illicitly export crude oil from Libya (the Libya Sanctions List), set out in paragraphs 15 and/or 17 of Security Council resolution 1970 (2011) and/or paragraph 19 of resolution 1973 (2011), or paragraph 10 of resolution 2146 (2014), adopted under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations:

Deadweight: 95,420. Flag State: India. The vessel may have been sold recently to an unknown buyer and the vessel's name may have changed to Kassos. As of 26 April 2016, the vessel was north of Al-Bayda, Libya, heading for Malta.

Reason for listing:

The vessel Distya Ameya (IMO: 9077343) was listed on 27 April 2016, pursuant to paragraphs 10(a) and 10 (b) of resolution 2146 (2014), as transporting crude oil illicitly exported from Libya, based on information received from the Government of Libya.
